### Notes:

[1] An average grade of C (2.0) must be obtained in major courses.

[2] Graduation with honors requires an additional 4 units in the major, CLCV 500 Senior Thesis. Completion of this course will reduce the number of upper division electives required.

[3] A maximum of 40 upper division units in any one department (including CLAR) will be accepted toward degree requirements.

[4] 30 of the last 36 units must be completed at LMU.

[5] Lower division language requirements may be waived based on prior instruction. Those units will be made up in the elective area.

[6] Units for required major course(s) that also meet the core will be counted towards the major. This does not take into consideration a major elective course(s) that may meet both a major and core requirement(s). If two required areas are met by one course, the outstanding units must be met in the Elective units total.

[7] Many CLAR courses fulfill the Core areas of FFYS, FRTA, EHAP, ECRE, IFTR, and IINC; students interested in double-majoring should consider these courses. If students complete these Core within the major, they will complete additional electives courses to fulfill the 124 minimum unit requirement for graduation.
