[2] Lower division FREN courses may be waived through the LMU French placement exam. The units are made up in the elective units.

[3] FREN 4990 is a Senior Capstone and must be completed in the last semester.

[4] A maximum of 40 units of upper division FREN is applicable to the degree.

[5] 30 of the last 36 units must be completed at LMU

[6] French courses in lower division (FREN 2102, 2103, 2104) can be waived without credit if students placed in upper division courses in their placement exam. Waived no-credit classes do not have to be made up to complete the French major. In the event that there are no courses in the language, students may take MDLG 3400, MDLG 4400, or FNLT 4200 (provided it is related to language concentration). If additional classes are not available in the Modern Languages and Literatures Department, students may fulfill those credits with courses in the appropriate cultural studies areas, with pre-approval from the French coordinator and the Department Chair.
