- [3] An average grade of C (2.0) is required in upper division courses included in the major.
- [4] At least two 3000 or 4000-level SOCL courses must be completed in the senior year.
- [5] 30 of the last 36 units must be completed at LMU.
- [6] See Bulletin for Theme Areas. Students must take one course from three of the six theme areas.
- [7] Units for required major course(s) that also meet the core will be counted towards the major. This does not take into consideration a major elective course(s) that may meet both a major and core requirement(s). If two required areas are met by one course, the outstanding units must be met in the Elective units total.
