[4] 30 of the last 36 units must be completed at LMU.

[5] Students with no previous knowledge of Spanish (i.e. those who were not placed into SPAN 2102 or above in the first semester) will be able to complete the program in four years if they are willing to take a Spanish course approved by our department, either abroad or at another institution during the summer.

[6] Spanish courses in lower division (SPAN 2101, 2102, 2103) can be waived without credit if students placed in SPAN 2804 in their placement exam. Waived no-credit classes do not have to be made up to complete the Spanish major. Credit earned from AP Language and/or Literature exams will be applied as general credits.

[7] Units for required major course(s) that also meet the core will be counted towards the major. This does not take into consideration a major elective course(s) that may meet both a major and core requirement(s). If two required areas are met by one course, the outstanding units must be met in the Elective units total.
