Notes on the Core

- [1] Only one course is required in each area of the Core. Many Undeclared students take an additional course from one or more Core areas they have completed. If 2 courses are completed in the same core area, the second course becomes an Elective.
- [2] *Many Social Science majors are required to take an additional Understanding Human Behavior course (upper or lower division) outside of the major. If you are exploring majors in the social sciences, learn the requirements to identify if you will need an additional EHBV Core.
- [3] The Engaged Learning Flag (LENL) may be taken any time before graduation. This is a Core requirement but it may also be an attribute in Major, Minor, or Elective classes.
