

PSYC MAJOR FIRST YEAR PLAN

The normal course load is 15 units per semester (5 classes). For most PSYC majors, the first year of courses would be as follows. The word "CORE" refers to courses that fulfill the requirements of the Core Curriculum-a series of courses taken by all LMU students regardless of their academic majors. This First Year Plan is part of the larger Four Year Plan. In four years, this plan meets all common graduation requirements.
