Notes:

[1] Students may take no more than ten upper division courses in any one department, except for Philosophy, in which the maximum is thirteen.

[2] An average grade of C (2.0) must be obtained in courses included in the major.

[3] Choose a concentration area from Archaeology, Art History, Classics, English, French, German, Greek, History, Italian, Latin, Philosophy, Spanish or Theology. The choice of concentration and of support courses must be formally accepted by your Humanities advisor.

[4] Seven 4-unit courses plus one 2-unit capstone (30 units) OR, for a concentration in Art History, five 3-unit courses, three 4-unit courses plus 2-unit capstone (29 units). Please note that this plan is designed with a 4-unit concentration; units per semester will alter slightly with an ARHS concentration.

[5] HMNT Capstone Project to be completed in the final semester.

[6] 30 of the last 36 units must be completed at LMU.

[7] Two thirds of the upper division units in the major must be completed at LMU.

[8] Units for required major course(s) that also meet the core will be counted towards the major. This does not take into consideration a major elective course(s) that may meet both a major and core requirement(s). If two required areas are met by one course, the outstanding units must be met in the Elective units total.

[9] 1000-Level foreign language is included in this four-year plan for those who do not initially test into a higher level course. These electives are taken to prepare students to complete the major requirement of one year foreign language study at the 2000-level.
