  - [2] CORE REQUIREMENTS: 1) Understanding Human Behavior Core; ECON 1050, POLS 1400, or POLS 1600 2) Historical Analysis & Perspectives: HIST 1000 level (*Except US History; HIST 13XX-14XX*) 3) Interdisciplinary Connections: POLS 4650.
  - [3] A maximum of 40 upper division units in IRLT will be accepted toward degree requirements. Minimum upper division POLS is 12 units.
  - [4] Up to two courses from Study Abroad may count towards the major. Consult IR Director.
  - [5] Students who attain a minimum GPA of 3.7, both overall and in the major, are eligible to enroll in POLS 5800 Honors Seminar in the fall and to write an Honors Thesis (POLS 5810) in the spring of their senior year.
  - [6] Once a student has enrolled at LMU and declared a International Relations major or minor, only LMU course work or courses from an LMU-approved study abroad program will be accepted for the major or minor.
  - [7] Units for required major course(s) that also meet the core will be counted towards the major. This does not take into consideration a major elective course(s) that may meet both a major and core requirement(s). If two required areas are met one course, the outstanding units must be met in the Elective units total.
