**Notes:**

[1] A minimum average grade of C+ (2.3) in Philosophy courses is required.

[2] At least two of these Electives must be upper-division courses taken at LMU.... At least one of these electives must be a 4000-level seminar... At least one elective in the major must focus on Contemporary Philosophy.

[3] 30 of the last 36 units must be completed at LMU.

[4] Students are strongly encouraged to study a foreign language to enhance their philosophical studies.

[5] Students are strongly encouraged to take the History of Philosophy sequence in chronological order.

[6] To graduate with Honors in Philosophy, students must take two additional Philosophy electives, at least one of which must be upper division, and must have a minimum GPA of 3.7 in Philosophy courses.
