3	The total number of electives required is determined by the lower division ECON and MATH options completed in the major.
4	This degree is suitable for pre-law students or those interested in careers in education, urban planning, federal, state and local government.
5	A maximum of 48 upper division units in ECON will be accepted toward degree requirements. Upper division courses should be taken at LMU, except by permission.
