4	Students may <b>not</b> register for any PSYC course for a <b>third</b> time without written permission of the Department Chairperson and Dean of the College.
5	At least 16 units of upper division PSYC and 30 of the last 36 units must be completed at LMU.
6	Units for required major course(s) that also meet the core will be counted towards the major. This does not take into consideration a major elective course(s) that may meet both a major and core requirement(s). If two required areas are met by one course, the outstanding units must be met in the Elective units total.
