



- Resources Tab is a place for useful resources such as ITS and Libguides.




MyLMU

ou can use the tabs and the search bar to find your specific interests.





Use LMU Cares (under the Campus Life tab) to find personal well-being and mental health tips.




Lion Jobs (under the employment tab) has postings about job opportunities on campus.

With DegreeWorks, you can also find your assigned academic advisor, ID number, and GPA




