

## BCLA Advising Center

- Provides advising support via 1:1 meetings with professional advisors and drop-in hours
- Addresses academic concerns e.g. 4-year plans, registration, interpreting degree audit etc.

## Academic Resource Center (ARC)

- Offers academic support services such as course tutoring and writing tutoring
- Provides specialized support for first-generation students through First to Go Program

## Katz Family Academic Skills Program

- Connects students with Learning Specialists and Academic Coaches for academic support
- Helps students enhance their study skills, time management, attention, focus and motivation

## Career and Professional Development (CPD)

- Provides career exploration support through 1:1 meetings with career advisors, job fairs and graduate school events, career planning/resume building resources etc.

## Study Abroad Office

- Offers a variety of semester and summer Study Abroad programs
- Students can attend program info sessions and connect with a Study Abroad advisor for additional support

## Office for International Students and Scholars (OISS)

- Provides programs and services that support LMU's international community
- Offers 1:1 meetings with OISS advisors and virtual drop-in hours for questions about visa compliance, CPT/OPT etc.

## Ethnic and Intercultural Services (EIS)

- Supports the intercultural learning and growth of diverse and underrepresented students
- Offers programs and services focused on identity building, advocacy, and community

## Community of Care (COC)

- Faculty can make a COC referral if they are concerned about a student's welfare and/or behavior
- COC case managers work with students to address issues and create an action plan

## Student Psychological Services (SPS)

- Provides in-person individual, group, and couples therapy
- Offers 24/7 virtual teletherapy via TimelyCare
- Walk-in consultations available for urgent cases

## Student Health Services (SHS)

- Provides general healthcare services by appointment only
- Students can receive treatment and prescriptions for medication

## Disability Support Services (DSS)

- Arranges individualized accommodations for students with disabilities
- Provides 1:1 advisement for students regarding disability issues
