COURSE DESCRIPTION/PRINCIPAL TOPICS:

Introduction to Fiction is a creative experience core course introducing strategies for creating fiction and writing about it as critics. As members of a literary community, participants develop the language to analyze fiction critically and academically. As practicing writers, participants create original works of fiction and analyze the form and technique involved in composing fiction. As we read, write, and analyze fiction, we also consider the role fictions play in shaping culture, and how they are shaped by it.
