ANCIENT LANDSCAPES | MODERN VOICES : MODERN GREEK SOCIETY & CULTURE (4 units) Interdisciplinary Connections | Engaged Learning

From the ancient paths of Delphi and Olympia to the modern metropolis of Athens, the mythical landscapes that visitors call in on their trip to Greece will come to life and reveal to us their eternal stories in the texts we will discuss. Students will discover a world still inhabiting the same landscape of Greek myths, yet a world in search of a modern global identity.

MANAGING PEOPLE AND ORGANIZATIONS (4 units) Engaged Learning

The course provides an introduction to Organizational Behavior (OB) and its practical applications in Human Resource Management (HRM) using the industry lens of global tourism, one of the biggest industries in Greece. Content includes an overview of core OB and HRM topics such as motivation, organizational culture, and learning and development. Students will compare, research, and reflect on OB and HRM best practices between the US and Greece. The course is aimed at all majors interested in understanding organizational behavior. It can be applied towards elective credit. It fulfills a requirement for all business majors.
