

Chinese Language and Culture

This year courses CHIN 1102 (Chinese 2), CHIN 2104 (Chinese 4), CHIN 3106 (Chinese 6), and CHIN 4108 (Chinese 8) have a unique opportunity to immerse and apply their language skills through coursework and travel in Beijing and Xi'an with their classmates and professors. There is no better way to develop language proficiency than through direct engagement in a native speaking environment! Beyond language learning, these courses and the trip to China aim to inspire a lasting appreciation for Chinese language and culture.

In Beijing, students will visit iconic cultural and historical sites such as the Forbidden City, Great Wall, Summer Palace, and Temple of Heaven. They will also experience the dynamic juxtaposition of old and new by walking through 800 year old alleyways in the city center. Students will then travel by bullet train to Xi'an. Xi'an is one of the cradles of ancient Chinese civilization, with a history spanning over 3,000 years, including more than 1,100 years as the capital of various dynasties. Highlights of the visit include the renowned Terracotta Warriors, the Mausoleum of the First Emperor of Qin, the Ancient City Wall, and the Xi'an History Museum. Students will be able to meet Chinese students through the Beijing Center.
