This course will help students develop language and literacy skills, as well as encourage exposure to and critical perspective on contemporary Chinese socio-cultural, political, and historical contexts. During the week-long immersion trip to Shanghai, Suzhou, and Nanjing, China, students will further their translingual and transcultural competence as they explore various historical and contemporary cultural sites including, Shanghai Museum, Lujiazui Central Business District, Presidential Palace, Confucius Temple, and more.
