

ECON 1998 (Fall) and ECON 2998 (Spring) Econ LLC

This course introduces students to the Department of Economics, the University, and college life. It aims to enrich student's experiences with the department by connecting them with other economics majors, economics alumni, and the economics faculty. Additionally, to prepare students for a successful college experience, it exposes students to many of the opportunities available on campus. Finally, through small group instruction, this course aims to assist students in transitioning to a college environment. This course is restricted to students participating in the Economics Linked Learning Community.

ECON 3998 Research Experience in ECON

In this one- to four-unit course, the student will have the opportunity to work closely with a professor on a research project in economics. In this capacity, the student will receive training in data collection, how to perform appropriate literature reviews, and/or how to edit papers in economics. The student will also be assessed at various stages of the course using suitable techniques.
